SonRise Ministries began life as Lutheran Disabilities Ministries working with youth 14 and older and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. The SonRise program is administered by Bethesda Lutheran Communities and Friendship Bible Studies are administered by Connection Ministry.

One of the major activities of both organizations is planting Bible Studies in local churches. The staffs help local congregations recruit volunteer leaders and companions to host a Bible Study group. The staffs provide training and support to the congregation to carry out an effective ministry. The assistance does not include recruiting members for the class or running the program, which are the responsibilities of each congregation.
